Thank you for sending in your photos - keep an eye out on the Year 3 Home Learning Page to see them there!



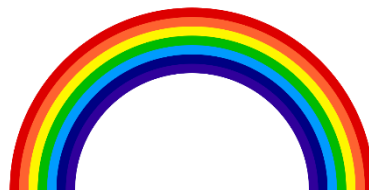
