Personification is a type of figurative language which gives an animal, plant or object human characteristics. It is used in fictional writing and image poetry to help describe things.

Here are some examples of personification.

The stars danced playfully in the sky. 

The printer ate the paper. 

The flowers nodded their heads as the wind blew. 

The ocean waves swallowed the boat. 

The old chair moaned as the boy jumped on it.
