

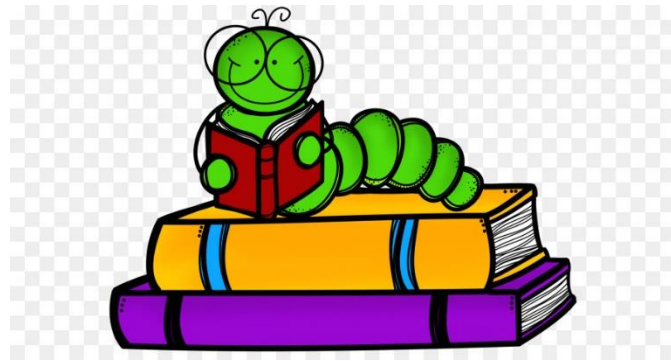
Weekly English Overview- Year 5
