I hope you all had a lovely week last week. I can see that many of you are continuing to work very hard at home and this makes us so proud. Well done and keep up the amazing work you are doing.




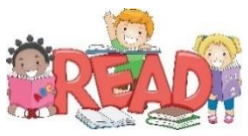
