

1, 2, 3, 4, 5 Vocabulary

Four	One more than 3.
Five	One more than 4.
Count	Say numbers one after the other in order. Point to or touch one object as you say each number.
How many?	The amount or number of things.
Represent	Show a number in different ways e.g. 5 frame, counters, numerals, dice etc.
1 More	Add 1 extra thing.
More	A greater amount.
Add	When you combine two groups and find out how many there are altogether.
1 Less	Take away 1 thing.
Subtract	Take away or remove some things.
Take Away	When you remove something and the amount you have reduces.
Make 4	All numbers are made up of smaller numbers. The numbers that make up 4 are 3 and 1 and 2 and 2.
Make 5	All numbers are made up of smaller numbers. The numbers that make up 5 are 4 and 1 and 3 and 2.
Part	When you break a whole down into two or more pieces, each piece is a part.
Whole	Everything together in one piece.
Altogether	You put everything together and count it all in one go.
