

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the last term of this academic year. I do hope you all had a lovely Easter break! Our whole school assemblies this week have focused on the season of Eastertide. This is a significant period in the liturgical calendar lasting 50 days up until the feast of Pentecost.

Thank you to all our parents in supporting the school's uniform policy, particularly regarding the girls' summer dresses. Your support is greatly appreciated. A reminder that all summer dresses must be **navy** and white check (**not pale blue** and white check). I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of the policy for boy's haircuts. We have had a number of haircuts after the Easter break that have not been in line with school policy. **As the uniform policy states, 'Hair should be conventionally cut with no visible lines and should be an appropriate length (not shaven or less than grade 2).**

I would like to thank everyone who kindly donated to the Father Hudson appeal during Lent. A grand total of £226.90 was raised for the £1 per child pledge and the additional money from the envelopes. If you have not yet sent in your money envelopes, please pass to the office as soon as possible so a final amount can be counted and sent to the Father Hudson society.
