Accommodation

Within the Château grounds schools are accommodated in an exclusive village of four bedded pods with their own shower and toilet block and dining facilities. Luxury Camping at the Château is a new concept of wooden pods, which are a cross between traditional canvas tents and wooden chalets. Each pod has electric lighting and heating and built-in bunkbeds.

What will my child need?

- ❖ Passport and GHIC card
- ❖ Sleeping bag
- ❖ €6 for Albert museum
- ❖ €30 spending money
- ❖ Packed breakfast and lunch (TBC dependant on travel times)
- ❖ Medication (if needed)
- ❖ Towels
- ❖ Torch
- ❖ Water bottle

Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC)

- o Your GHIC lets you get state healthcare at a reduced cost or sometimes for free. It will cover you for treatment that is needed to allow you to continue your stay until your planned return.
- o Every child will need a card which will be carried by Mrs Statham whilst in France, along with the collective passport.

Cost & Reminders

- o The cost of the trip will be £600
- o Initial (non refundable) deposit £100 due by 1st February 2026
- o Second (non refundable) deposit £50 due by 1st March 2026
- o The balance of £450 can then either be paid;
- o In full via Arbor by **June 2026**; or
- o 13 monthly payments
- o Children will need a passport to travel

Cost & Reminders

- o 13 monthly payments by standing order:
- o Payments will begin on **1st April 2026**
- o Last payment will be **1st April 2027**
- o This will comprise of x12 monthly payments of £35 and the final payment of £30
- o If you choose the standing order option you must complete a standing order form and return it to the office no later than **1st February 2026**
