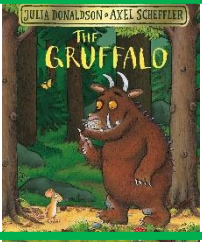


**Vocabulary we learn and use this week:**

I can use numbers to show the parts.

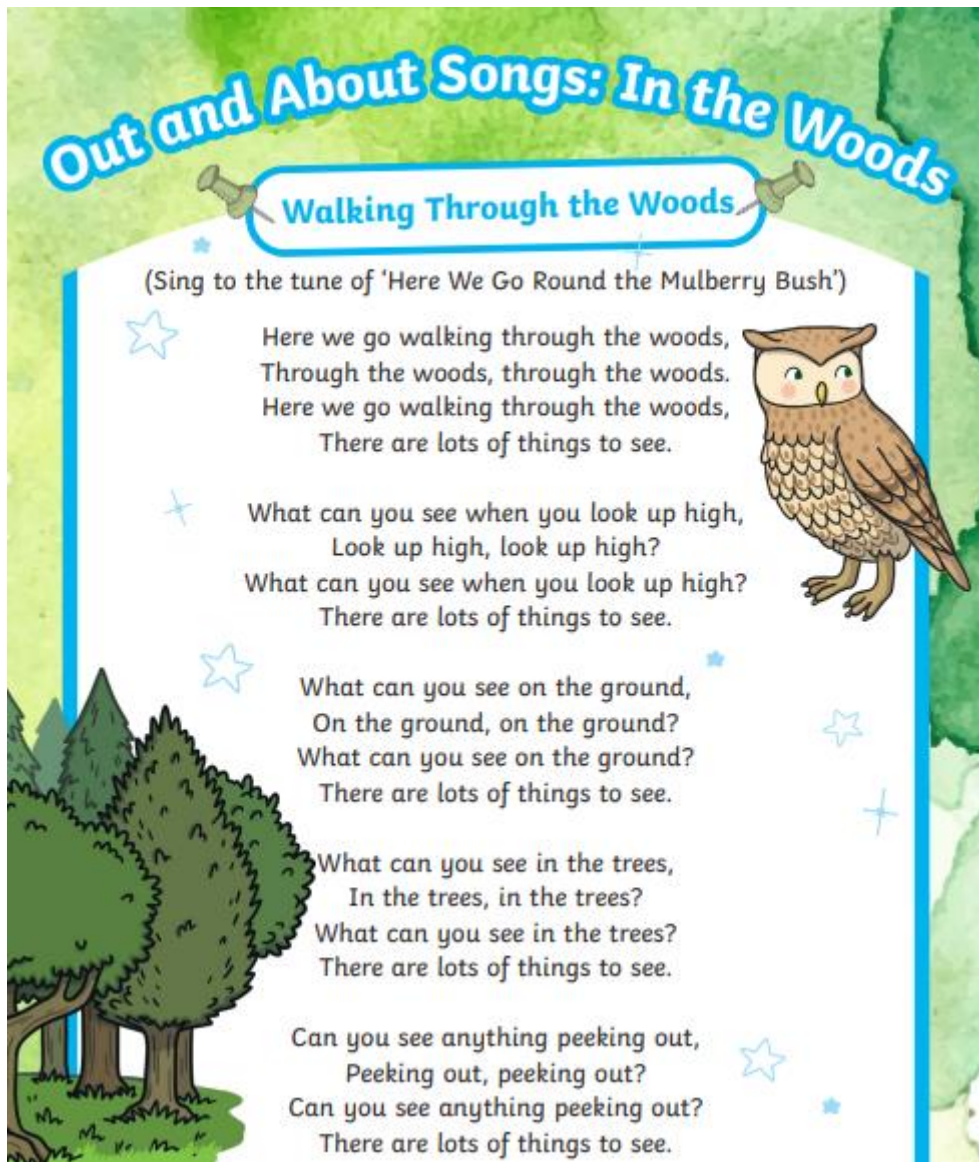
One part is the 🍪. The other part is the 🍰.
