Young Voices Tickets and final arrangements

Our exciting performance in the Young Voices concert on Thursday 15th January is getting closer. There are a few things to do before the day itself.

1. Tickets

The audience tickets are electronic only and will be accessed through the AXS ticketing app. We have the tickets in the school account and will be transferring them electronically using the email address that this letter was sent to. You will receive an email from AXS asking you to download the app to access your tickets. It is important that you use the same email address as a login or you won't be able to see your tickets. Tickets need to be shown on screen on the night, so please make sure your phone / device is charged. There are no paper tickets.

2. T-shirts and torches

T-shirts and torches have arrived in school and will be distributed in January.

3. On the day

We will be having an early lunch at school. This can be a school meal or a packed lunch from home. Children need to bring with them:

- a packed meal to eat after the rehearsal including a drink.
- A separate bottle of water
- A t-shirt (Plain white or Young Voices branded. It can be a YV t-shirt from a previous concert)
- A warm coat
- Asthma inhaler if required

We are due back to St Mary's school about 10.30pm. Children **must** be collected from the church car park at St Mary's Church, Ford Green Road, ST6 8LT, not the NEC.



4. Final practice

We will have a final practice of all songs without using lyrics sheets after school on Wednesday 14th January from 3.20pm to 4.20pm. The children need to know all lyrics by heart for the concert and have brought lyric sheets home. Practice resources are also available on Spotify; please encourage your child to keep practising over the Christmas break so they don't forget the words.
