Year 4 will be taking part in a special Railway 200 learning programme to support our curriculum work next term.

Railway 200 celebrates 200 years of train travel and explores how railways have shaped our country through science, technology, engineering, maths (STEM), history and safety.

The class will explore a range of engaging activities such as:

- Learning about the Stockton & Darlington Railway, its history, and how it changed people's lives.
- Using interactive resources that link maths, science and design technology to real rail-related problems.
- Completing safety and decision-making activities to support their personal and social understanding.
