Our learning this week –

Phonics – This week we are recapping all of the phase 2 sounds and using these to read words and sentences. We will also be recapping our tricky words.

This week we would like you to take the opportunity to practise recognising number to 10 – as numerals, in the environment, as tally marks, dots, objects and so on.

We would like you to count up to 10 from a given number e.g. start at 6 and count up to 10/ start at 10 and count down to 4.
