

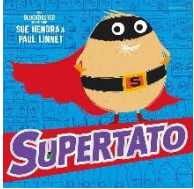
Vocabulary we learn and use this week:

We will then begin our zig zag letters – v, w, x, z



Our Maths Focus this week is:


