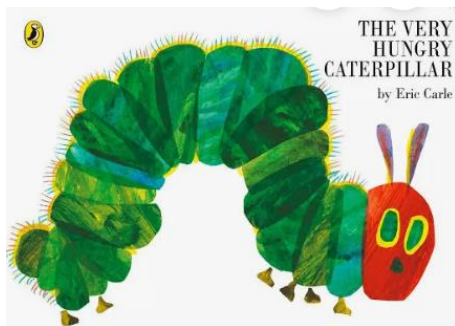


Focus words: Pentecost. Spirit, air and the sign of the cross. Talk about the words and what they mean. Use the words within a sentence throughout the week.
