

Weekly Parent Focus

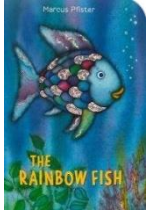
Week Beginning: 1st June 2026

Vocabulary we learn and use this week:

R.E: Prayer, talking, praise, thanks, Our Father, Hail Mary

Maths: share, half, halving, fair share, equal, equal groups, each, pattern, double facts, five frame

Topic: scale, ocean, kind, friends, shiny.



Focus story: The rainbow fish

Our learning this week –

Phonics – This week we will recap all previous sounds before moving on to new sounds. Children will be writing magic sentences daily, using their phonics knowledge.

R.E – This week the children will be introduced to our new unit 'Prayer'.

Handwriting – As the children have completed the handwriting letter families, they will write daily simple sentences using their phonics and handwriting knowledge.

Our Maths Focus this week is:

This week, children will focus on halving quantities by sharing into two equal groups. They will make links to the fact that halving is the opposite, or inverse, of doubling.
