

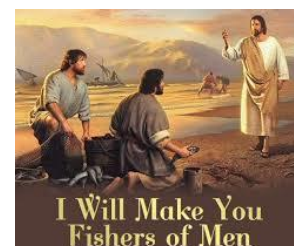
Year 1 Curriculum Information

Maths

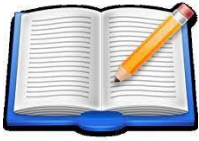

**Number Place Value Measurements**

<p>Science</p> 	<p>We will be finishing off our <b>Everyday Material</b> unit and then focusing in on the changes that occur during each <b>season</b> and what it means to our life such as growing, holidays, clothes etc.</p>	
<p>History</p> 	<p>Building on what we learnt last half term in Geography about the coast, we will be learning all about the <b>seaside in the past</b> and the important role it played in the lives of people. We will look at <b>differences and similarities</b>, what we could see <b>then</b> and what we can see <b>now</b>.</p> <p><i>Does the fun of being chased by the waves ever change?</i></p>	
<p>DT</p>	<p>We will be thinking about making a shelter. We will focus on the words, strong, stiff and stable.</p> <p>To help us, we will be using and testing out all kinds of materials, thinking about the best house for the Three Little Pigs.</p>	
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>We will be focusing on <b>multi-skills</b> and <b>practising the sports day race favourites!</b></p> <p>All named PE kits should be kept in school at all times so that we can make the most of every opportunity to practise!</p> <p>We will also be going <b>swimming</b> every Tuesday pm so please ensure that all named swimming kit is in school for Tuesday, including a towel!</p> <p><i>NB: If you wish your child to wear goggles, please write a small note to myself and ask your child to hand it over to me before swimming sessions begin.</i></p>	 
<p>IT</p> 	<p>We will be taking a look at '<b>spreadsheets</b>' and '<b>Tech outside of school</b>'.</p> <p>Through these units, the children will begin to understand the opportunities and basic uses of IT.</p>
