







Term	Picture	Definition
<b>Book</b>		Words and pictures on a page which we read.
<b>Draw</b>		To make a picture of something or something.
<b>Label</b>		To write information on something.
<b>Name</b>		The word that a person, thing or place is known by.
<b>Page</b>		A piece of paper in a book with words and pictures on.
<b>Picture</b>		A drawing, painting or photograph in a book.
<b>Read</b>		To say words that are written
<b>Talk</b>		To say words aloud.
<b>Text</b>		The written words in a book.
<b>Write</b>		To make marks which show meaning.

Alphabet		26 letters in order from A to Z.
Author		The writer of a book.
Fiction		A made up story.
Grapheme		A letter or letters that match a phoneme in a word.
Letter		A to Z written down to match sounds
Phoneme		A sound.
Rhyme		A word that has the same last sound as another word.
Sentence	I went to the park.	A group of words put together which make sense.
