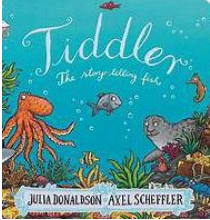
Week Beginning: 15th June 2026

Vocabulary we learn and use this week:

R.E: Prayer, talking, praise, thanks, Our Father, Hail Mary

Maths: odd, even, share, equal, groups, teams, more, pattern.

Topic: sea, swim, help, treasure, Island.



Focus story: Tiddler

Rhyme of the week: 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive.

Our learning this week –

Phonics – This week we will recap all previous sounds before moving on to new sounds. Children will be writing magic sentences daily, using their phonics knowledge.

R.E – This week the children will be introduced to our new unit 'Prayer'.

Handwriting – As the children have completed the handwriting letter families, they will write daily simple sentences using their phonics and handwriting knowledge.

Our Maths Focus this week is:

This week, children will explore how shapes can be composed and decomposed and be able to recognise that a shape can have other shapes within it, just as a number can. Children will explore the attributes of shapes through many hands-on activities while discovering, describing, proving and predicting. They will experience building a combination of figures as a single new figure.

Things to remember:

- Swimming will be every Tuesday – please ensure all children bring swimming trunks/costume, towel and swimming cap. If you wish for your child to wear goggles please provide a letter with written permission.
- Please keep word purses and books in book bags each day so that we can read with the children in school
