

Weekly Parent Focus

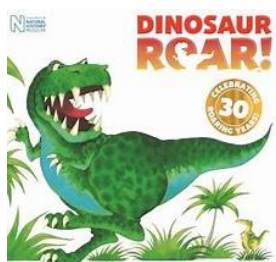
Week Beginning: 13th September

Vocabulary we learn and use this week:

R.E: Bible, God, creation, gifts.

Topic: name, boy, girl, hair, eyes, like, dislike, emotions, feelings, mum, dad, family, race, home, school, family, house, people, different, hope, culture, experience, respect, dream, feelings, discrimination, heritage, nationality, adaptation, belonging.

Maths: 1, 2, 3 one, two, three, number, count, count forwards, count backwards



Focus story: Dinosaur Roar

Rhyme of the week: If you're a dinosaur and you know it.



Our learning this week –

Phonics – Phase 2 – We will introduce 'p' and 'i'. We learn about the sound this grapheme make, what things begin with this sound and whether we can spot it in the environment.

R.E – We will introduce our first unit – Creation. We will take the children on a Creation work and recall parts of the Creation story.

Topic – This week we will continue to think about Ourselves, our feelings and our family and community. We will also be learning all about dinosaurs and be taking part in the national fitness week on Wednesday!

Our Maths Focus this week is:

Numbers to 5 – We will focus on –

- Recognising number
- Counting
- Counting 1 object at a time (1:1 correspondence)
- Representations of numbers (e.g. - fingers, dots, numerals, objects)
- Cardinality (matching quantity to number)
