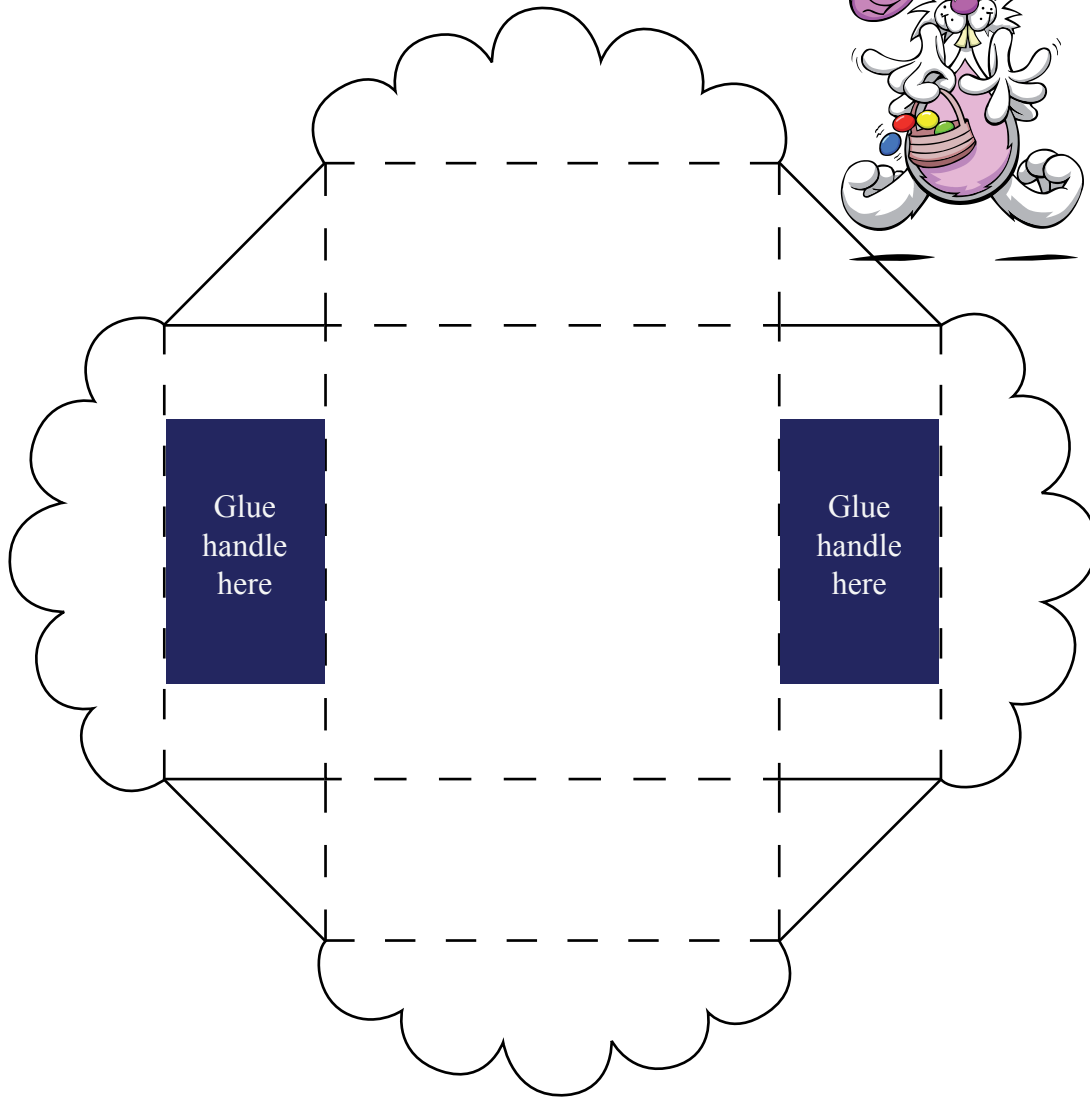


Net an Easter Basket

Colour in the net and handle before you make it into a basket.



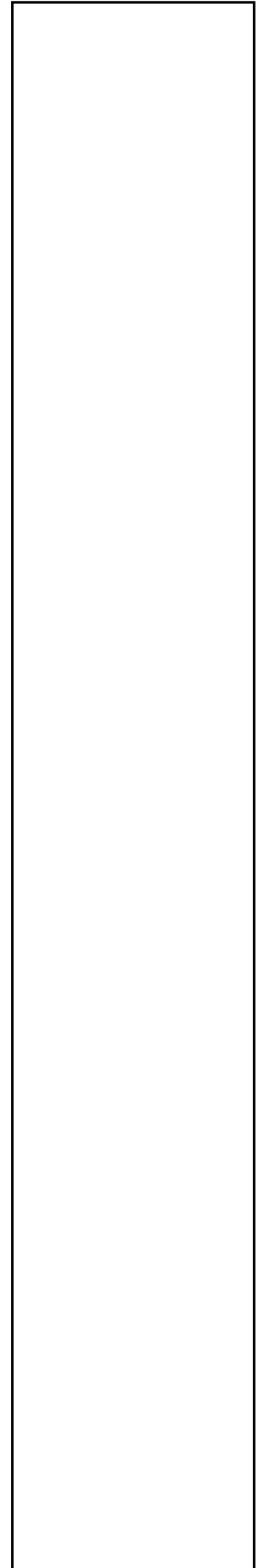
Fold the net around the square base.

The top leafs can then be folded outwards.

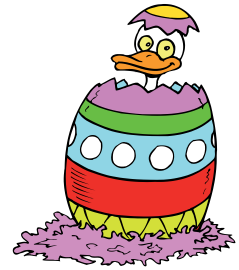
Glue/staple the handle to the inside of the basket where shown.
