How do you think Jesus felt about the lepers who came to him? Remember to give reasons why.

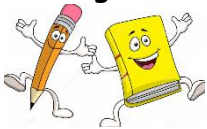
In what ways were the lives of the men changed through their meeting with and being healed by Jesus?
